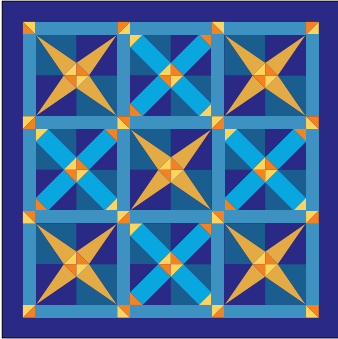

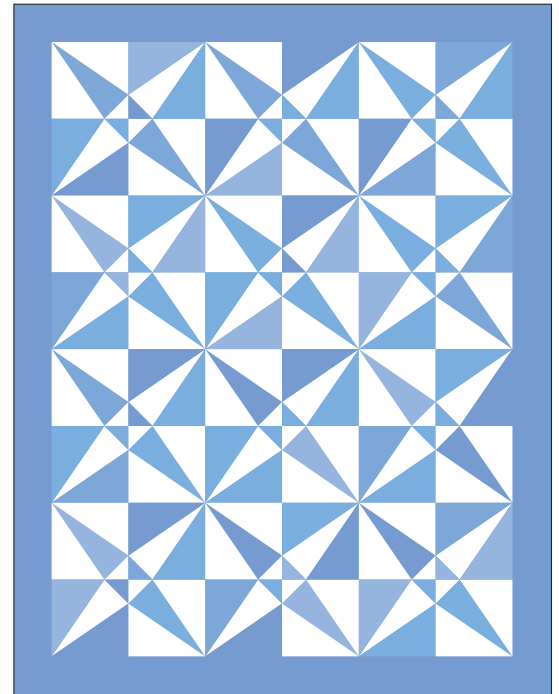

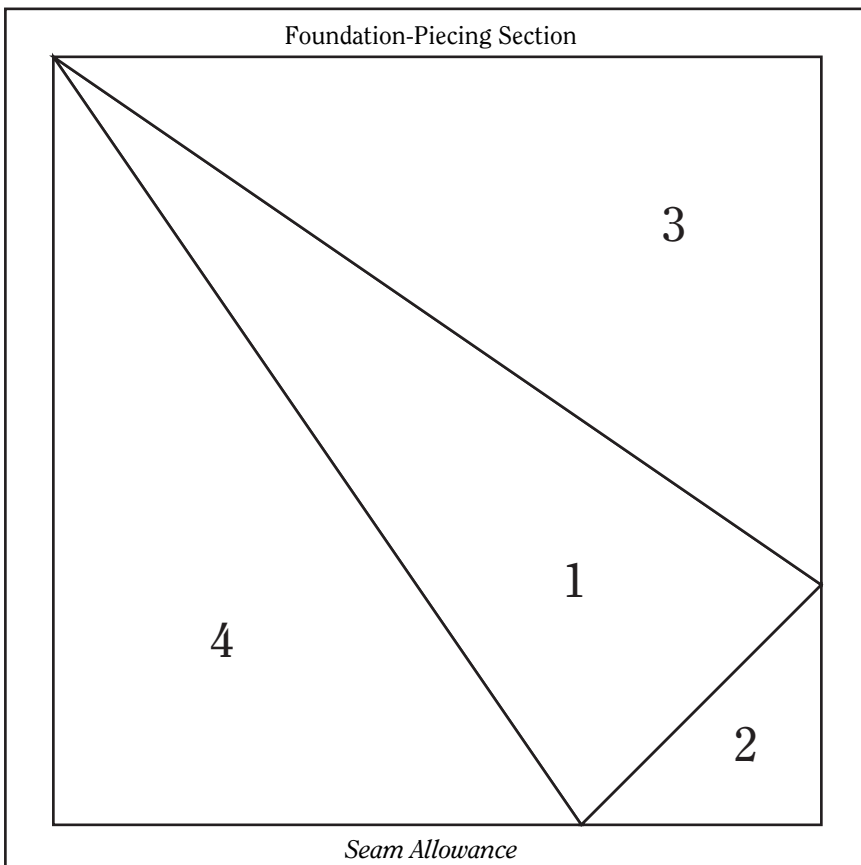
Foundation piece a few of your old favorites, compliments of QUILTMAKER magazine!

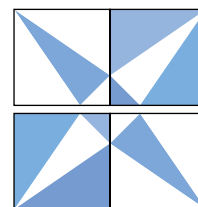


Foundation-Piecing Section



Use the pattern at left to create four sections of the "Crossed Canoes" block, then assemble according to block diagram.

Sizes given are for an 8" block. If desired, enlarge or reduce the foundation pattern for alternate sizes.
