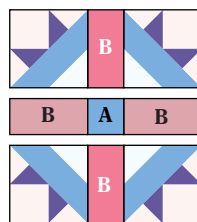
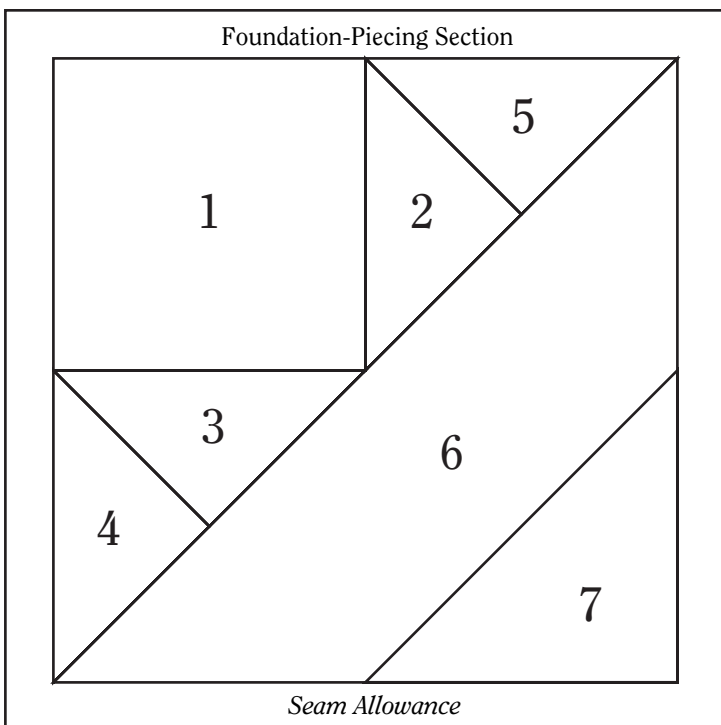

Use the pattern at left to create the corner portions of the "Cross and Crown" block. Rotary cut one 2" square A patch, and four 2" x 3 3/4" B patches for each block. Match grainlines as indicated on A and B patch diagrams. Assemble block according to piecing diagram at left.

Sizes given are for an 8" block. If desired, enlarge or reduce the foundation pattern, A and B patch for alternate sizes.
